The Haxtun Town Council met for a special meeting at 7:00 p.m. The meeting was opened by Mayor Mike Ensminger at the Haxtun Town Hall. Roll call was taken with the following council members present Bob Cionek, Dean Anderson, Tana Pope, Ryan Horton, Lori Lundgren, Dave Green. Mayor Ensminger led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Staff members present were Tom Bullard, Police Chief, Ron Carpenter, Superintendent, and Kelsey Harms, Town Clerk/Treasurer.

Darcy Garretson was also in attendance.

The regular meeting started with a public hearing for the 2024 budget. Discussion was held on any changes reflected in the budget worksheet, including the assessed valuation after the Colorado special legislative session, COLA increases for employees, the new siren grant opportunity, and the increase in water rates. After no further discussion, the hearing was closed at 7:09 pm

Mayor Ensminger then opened the public hearing for the special event liquor license for the Little Sprouts Learning Center Gala. A map for the event was presented to the Council, Chief Bullard had no issues with the event. No further discussion was held, and the hearing was closed at 7:10 pm.

RESOLUTION TO SET MILL LEVIES

A RESOLUTION LEVYING GENERAL PROPERTY TAXES FOR THE YEAR 2024 TO HELP DEFRAY THE COSTS OF GOVERNMENT FOR THE TOWN OF HAXTUN, COLORADO, FOR THE 2024 BUDGET YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Haxtun have adopted a budget in accordance with Local Government Budget Law, on December 18th, 2023.

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for general operating expenses is \$191,680 and;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Board of Trustees of the Town of Haxtun, Colorado.

SECTION I: That the purpose of meeting all general operating expenses of the Town of Haxtun during the 2024 Budget Year, there is hereby levied a tax of 22.630 mills upon each dollar of the total valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the Town for the year 2024.

SECTION II: That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to immediately certify to the County Commissioners of Phillips County, Colorado, the mill levies for the Town of Haxtun as herein above determined and set.

2023 SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET APPROPRIATIONS

WHEREAS, authority is granted by the Colorado Revised Statutes to amend the adopted budget for the current fiscal year, and

WHEREAS, those adjustments to the 2023 Budget which are necessary for the town's 2023 operations could not have been reasonably foreseen at the time of the adoption of the 2023 Budget; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has been advised by the Town Clerk/Treasurer that the revision to the 2023 Budget as contained within this resolution can adequately be implemented as set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Trustees of the Town of Haxtun, Colorado, that

The 2023 appropriations for the Water Fund shall be increased \$5,000.00 from \$260,767 to \$265,767 to meet unappropriated expenditures of the Water Fund including necessary interior and exterior water tower repairs.

The 2023 appropriations for the Sanitation Fund shall be increased \$5,000.00 from \$188,540 to \$193,540 to meet unappropriated expenditures of the Sanitation Fund including additional wages and higher landfill expenses.

At the December 4 meeting, the Council reviewed a title commitment and warranty deed for the 205 S Colorado Ave property that is to be donated to the Town. The title commitment statement needed to be updated to show the appropriate fees and the Council was also informed that the current owners would be paying the 2023 taxes. With the updates, the council agreed that the information presented was correct. A motion was made by T. Pope and seconded by R. Horton to approve the title commitment and warranty deed with the closing costs of \$908.82. All present voted in favor, motion passed.

V. Freemyer the Police Department Clerk was working on an emergency siren grant that would update the emergency sirens in the Town. Freemyer and the Town were awarded the 90/10 Division of Homeland Security and Emergency grant, the total project cost is \$49,078.85. The grant needed the Council to appoint someone to be the small dollar grant agreement signer. A motion was made by D. Green and seconded by R. Horton to appoint Ron Carpenter as the approved signer. All present voted in favor, motion passed.

A letter of resignation from Dean Anderson was read by Mayor Ensminger. The council will have 60 days to fill the vacant seat or hold a special election. A motion was made by D. Green and seconded by R. Horton to accept the resignation. All present voted in favor; motion passed. Dean was thanked by the Council for his year of service to the Town.

Discussion Items

The Council further discussed a draft preservation ordinance. The ordinance will work with the Main Street Dola program. The Council liked two examples and wants to work those examples into an ordinance that will work for Haxtun. Kelsey would work on the draft and bring it back to the Council at the next meeting.

There were no other items on the agenda. The meeting adjourned at 7:40 pm subject to the call of the Mayor.
